## Call for Applications - Joint Academic Positions Escuela de Administración and Instituto por el Desarrollo Sustentable Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile

### **SECOND CALL: DEADLINE JULY 29TH, 2022**

The Business School (Escuela de Administración) and the Institute for Sustainable Development (IDS) at Pontificia Universidad Católica (PUC) de Chile seek candidates for up to two full-time tenure track joint positions as either Assistant or Associate Professor. The positions are in any field relevant for Sustainability and Business Administration **starting between August 2022 and March 2023**. Candidates should have a Ph.D. (completed or imminent), and demonstrate a strong commitment to research in Business and Sustainability. Candidates with a proven successful research track may also apply for Associate Professor positions.

The appointment requires the selected candidate to have half of their work load in each of the two units, both in their teaching, research, and service work. The chosen candidate should maintain a balance regarding their contribution to both units.

Salaries, teaching loads, and research funds are competitive. Knowledge of Spanish is not required at the beginning, and we provide support for the candidate to adopt it within the first 2 years. The Business School is a leading institution in Latin America with undergraduate, graduate and executive education programs, and a strong commitment to research. The IDS is an interdisciplinary academic unit that seeks to link the issues of sustainability and sustainable development across academic units at PUC, and in collaboration with organizations outside the University.

Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile recognizes and values the importance of diversity and inclusion in enriching its employee's experience and in supporting its academic mission. The University is committed to attracting and retaining employees with varying genders, identities, and backgrounds.

The candidate should have a demonstrated capacity to develop high quality research and a commitment to excellence in teaching. Capacity to work in an interdisciplinary environment is also required in this joint position and the willingness to contribute to activities in both units. Candidates wishing to be considered for an appointment as Associate Professor must demonstrate a good publication record.

Qualified candidates are encouraged to apply and should include

- Research statement.
- Teaching statement indicating the kind of courses they would be more interested to teach
